What is the Summer Food Service Program?

The Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) was established to ensure that children continue to receive nutritious meals when school is not in session. The SFSP is a federally funded program operated nationally by the USDA and administered in Delaware by the Department of Education.

- Free meals that meet Federal nutrition guidelines are provided during the summer months to children 18 years old and under.
- Sites are located throughout Delaware – in schools, churches, parks, and camps. Information on how to locate summer sites is included on this flyer under “How Families Can Find Summer Sites”.
